[PREZODE : Preventing ZOonotic Disease Emergence – pillar 1]

Concept of the event

The Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework, agreed at the 15th meeting of the Conference of Parties to the UN Convention on Biological Diversity gives hope for a synchronization of agendas between sustainable ecosystem management and One Health prevention strategies. Indeed, the PREZODE initiative is based on the design of strategies to prevent the emergence or re-emergence of zoonoses through sustainable management of ecosystems. Two years after its launch by President Macron at the One Planet Summit (January 2021), the PREZODE initiative now includes 18 governments and nearly 180 institutions worldwide. The PREZODE initiative is now entering a new phase of its international deployment after a co-construction process of more than 18 months that brought together more than 1800 stakeholders in more than 120 countries, and the development of its strategic agenda.

The One forest Summit is an opportunity to draw up a progress report involving high-level actors and to continue its expansion through both the adhesion of new governments to the initiative and the raising of new funding for all the actions identified during the co-construction process and constituting the strategic agenda of PREZODE.
